Phase IV Water Supply Project Continues

South Walton Utility and Destin Water Users have joined together as WRP to ensure our communities have a secure source of potable water for the future.



"We appreciate the communities' support as we work to construct a waterline that will take us to build out", said Pete DeBogory, General Manager of South Walton Utility.

With a \$2.5M grant from the Northwest Florida Water Management District and a low interest loan from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection the project is fast becoming a reality. From wells at the General Bill Brown Wellfield, north of Freeport, water will be transmitted through a thirty-inch pipe down Highway 331, cross under the Choctawhatchee Bay, and connect to our existing pipeline in the Gulf Power right of way off of Highway 331. The scheduled completion date is October 2013.

A Letter from the President

This letter shares both sad and hopeful news. On February 17, 2012 Mr. Jack McGill, President of the South Walton Utility Company Board of Directors passed away in his sleep. Our utility was fortunate to have Jack's tenacious leadership and concern for our customers at the helm for many years. Jack was an avid golfer and was always eager to play for our utility in charity tournaments. His favorite charity was the Sacred Heart Hospital of the Emerald Coast. Through the years Jack raised many thousands of dollars to insure his community had a first rate hospital. Jack was our President, a community leader and a philanthropist, and he is missed.

The President's gavel passed to me soon after Jack McGill's death. Remembering his legacy, it is now a pleasure to share some of the hopeful news about South Walton Utility Co. Inc. (SWUCI), the company he guided so well. The pipeline project is moving ahead. Pete DeBogory, our General Manager, is sharing details about the project with you elsewhere in this newsletter, but a couple of things deserve emphasis. The pipeline project is the most cost effective way to fill the water production needs of SWUCI and Destin Water Users (DWU) through expected build-out several decades down the road. The partnership we have with DWU is strong and it is helping both of our private utilities give members some of the best and most affordable service in the region. Employees of both utilities work shoulder to shoulder in the field managing construction and others work in our respective offices managing permitting, contracts and financing to make this an on-time and on-budget project.

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Did you know....

environmental groups, decided that it is in the best interests of the nation to mandate the adoption of numeric nutrient criteria for the State of Florida. These environmental groups have the opinion that degradation in Florida water is out of control and getting worse. The best scientists in Florida have not been able to develop any scientifically defensible correlation between the levels of nitrogen and phosphorus (nutrients) in the water and imbalances of fish and plant communities in Florida water.

The State of Florida is home to the most advanced wastewater plants of any state.

The EPA, under pressure from a few We are the leaders in the reuse of reclaimed water. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection is unrelenting in their enforcement of environmental regulation. We protect the environment.

> If the Numeric Nutrient Criteria rule is implemented as it is currently stated it will mean a 50 - 100% increase in sewer bills.

Numerous agencies are intervening in court asking the EPA to reconsider or let measurements cannot detect them. DEP handle the numeric nutrient criteria rule.

Every year South Walton Utility conducts regarding these test results or would water quality tests ranging from Aluminum to Xylenes to ensure that our water quality meets all Federal and State requirements.

We conduct over 300 chlorine residual tests per month to verify disinfection has been maintained in the water distribution system.

In 2011 we conducted over 80 tests on analytes from groups such as Synthetic Organic Contaminants and Volatile Organic Contaminants that test for naturally occurring as well as man-made material. The majority of these analytes are so low laboratory


A Letter from the President
